1. Authority Granted

3. Compliance with Law

4. Limitations

This authority does not permit the Authorised Person to sell, lease, encumber, or otherwise dispose of the vehicle unless expressly authorised in writing by the Owner.

5. Revocation

The Owner may revoke this authority at any time by providing written notice to the Authorised Person and relevant authorities. Revocation shall not affect any actions taken prior to receipt of such notice.

6. Governing Law

This Letter of Authority shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Victoria, Australia.

7. Severability

If any provision of this Letter of Authority is found to be invalid or unenforceable, the remaining provisions shall remain in full force and effect.

8. Entire Agreement

This Letter of Authority constitutes the entire agreement between the parties with respect to the subject matter herein and supersedes all prior agreements and understandings, whether written or oral.

9. Execution in Counterparts

This Letter may be executed in counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original and all of which together shall constitute one instrument.

10. Definitions

In this Letter of Authority, unless the context otherwise requires, words and expressions shall have the meanings assigned to them under Victorian law.
